

Instructions for Preparation of Posters

The usable space on each poster board is 97 cm (39 inches) wide by 240 cm (94 inches) high. The title and authors should be printed in large characters (greater than 3.5 cm high) at the top of the poster. The remaining text in the poster presentation should be at least 0.7 cm high so that it is easily visible from a distance of ~1 meter.

The poster sessions will be located in the Rhodes room. Posters should be setup on the morning of the day they are scheduled for presentation. Posters should be removed immediately following the conclusion of the session. Adhesive system will be available on the poster board to attach the posters.

Each poster presentation will be assigned a space. The space number is given in the final printed conference program. Note there may be differences between the final printed program and the preliminary program uploaded to the ICFRM web site. To further assist authors in locating their assigned space, each poster board will be labeled in the upper left hand corner with the space number.

Each poster session is scheduled for 2 hours. Presenters should stand by their posters for at least half of the session period. Chairmen of the poster sessions are asked to report on presenters presence.
